To All Visitors:

On March 19, 2020 **California Governor Gavin Newsom Issued Executive Order N-33-20**, (the “Governor’s Order”) commonly reported as the ‘Stay-at-Home’ order. The Governor’s Order directs all individuals living in the State of California to stay home or at their place of residence, except as needed to maintain continuity of operations of the Federal Critical Infrastructure Sectors.

As a provider of critical infrastructure goods, services and agricultural skill in the **Food And Agriculture Sector of DHS-CISA** <https://www.cisa.gov/food-and-agriculture-sector>, Zuckerman Heritage Inc., Delta Bluegrass Company, Zuckerman Family Farms, and Delta Farms Packing will continue operations pursuant to and in support of the Governor’s Order.

Also on March 19, 2020, the Chair of the San Joaquin County Board of Supervisors Issued a Response directing business and individuals to observe specific terms and restrictions.
